As the Police Liaison Representative (PLR), I am a link between the local police and parishioners: to aid communication and to promote means of reducing crime. To this end, I have provided useful information in editions of the Boddington Bugle.

In the past year, I have organised local Police presence at the Friday coffee morning in the Village Hall.

Note that I don't work for the Police and I'm not a Parish Councillor. The role is not a replacement for reporting crime, which should be through: calling 999 if an emergency; calling 101; or using the Northamptonshire police website.

Each month I report the crime for the Parish to the Parish Council. Over the last twelve months this has been:

Vehicle crime	6	(was 9 in the previous year)
Criminal damage & arson	0	(was 4 in the previous year)
Burglary	4	(was 4 in the previous year)
Violence & sexual offences	8	(was 12 in the previous year)
Anti-social behaviour	5	(was 2 in the previous year)
Other theft	5	(was 2 in the previous year)
Public order	2	(was 0 in the previous year)
